FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

a guide to starting the marching season off right

When is band camp?

The UHS Band Camp for the is almost always the one to two weeks before school starts. You can go ahead and mark it in your calendar for next school year!

Why do I need to attend Band Camp?

The band is one of the most involved groups on campus – and one of the most visible to our community. Our first performance of the year will take place during the first week of school! So, just like the football team and the cheerleading squad, we must practice over the summer to prepare. Band Camp also helps us lock-in our numbers on the field – every time a new member is added or a member has to be removed, we have to rewrite the drill and move performers' spots. It's imperative that every member attends camp so that the start to our marching season can begin smoothly!

What if I miss band camp?

As stated above, every time a member is added or removed, we must rewrite the drill and move performers' spots. It's imperative that every member attends camp so that the drill can remain as accurate as possible from the start. If you are unable to attend camp, we cannot promise that your spot on the field will be held for you. Please contact Mr. Innis ASAP if there are any conflicts during band camp.

Do I have to be in the Marching Band?

Yes. Marching Band is a requirement of the FLDOE. The band curriculum covers marching band, and we will follow the curriculum. Marching Band only runs through the beginning of November, so don't be discouraged! It is FUN! You get to play cool music, put on a show, go to football games for free, hang out with your friends, and more.

Marching Band VS Physical Education

Recently, the state Senate passed Florida House Bill 1105. This states that students who **complete two full seasons of marching band** with a grade of "C" or better can satisfy the one-credit requirement for physical education! An easy "A".... show up to rehearsals, play at the football games, get an A, earn a PE credit!

How much time does Marching Band take up during the week?

Mandatory Marching Band Rehearsals are every Monday and Thursday from 3:00 – 5:30. Football Games are most Fridays. These are the only times we get to practice our show on the field. Band is a team sport – all teammates are expected to show up and practice with the team. Would a football player get to skip practice and still get to play in the game? Would a cheerleader be excused from practice to work their parttime job and still be allowed to be at the top of the pyramid? Marching Band is as much a physical activity as it is a creative one – be dedicated to yourself, your bandmates, and the program and show up to rehearsals! Any students who miss rehearsal (pre-arranged or otherwise) must communicate with Mr. Innis in a timely manner.

Does band interfere with sports or student club activities?

Band does **NOT** interfere with any student activities. Many members of the UHS Marching Bulldogs are involved in sports, clubs, AP/Cambridge classes, dual-enrolled, and more! We have band members successfully involved in MULTIPLE groups on campus. The key to being involved is COMMUNICATION! If you ever get double booked, it is YOUR responsibility to contact Mr. Innis to make arrangements for missing a band event.

How much does band cost?

We are proud of the fact that our band fees are among the lowest in the county. With a budget nearing \$40,000, there are costs associated with being in the band program. However, music is for EVERYONE and we will work with you to ensure that no student is ever turned away due to financial hardship.

How can I join colorguard?

We are looking for anyone interested in having fun, making friends, and helping to make Friday night football games a BLAST!!! The members of the COLORGUARD specialize in the visual interpretation of music through the movement of the body and equipment - flags, rifles, and sabers, and more! Additionally, as a member of the colorguard you will earn both a FINE ARTS and PE credit at the same time! Any students are welcome to join – invite your friends! No band/music/dance experience needed!

Does the band travel?

YES, ALL THE TIME! We are constantly getting on a bus and going somewhere... away games, competitions, concerts, etc. We also take an out-of-state trip every other year! I wonder where we will be going in April 2026...? #BandRoadTrip

Is high school band fun?

ABSOLUTELY!!! I guarantee that you will have the time of your life as a member of our UHS Bulldog Band. Concerts, pep rallies, football games, basketball games, competitions, parades, social nights, and more... they are all a BLAST, and you're making memories that will last a lifetime!!! #bandforever

Why should I become a volunteer?

The band at Umatilla High School is the largest student organizations on campus. With a budget nearing \$40,000 we need every family to help out with fundraisers, concession stands, uniform distribution, equipment maintenance, chaperoning, and more! Parents are the backbone of our band program!

How do I sign up?

Login or create an account on <u>Raptor</u>. Scan the QR code to access the volunteer sign up on the LCS website! Make sure you email the UHS Volunteer Coordinator, Stephanie Caruso (<u>CarusoS@lake.k12.fl.us</u>) and Mr. Innis (<u>InnisY@lake.k12.fl.us</u>) once you have completed your online application. You will receive a confirmation email once your application is complete. Emails will be sent out once a final determination is made.



How long does my volunteer status last?

Your volunteer status will last THREE years! It's free to sign up and get fingerprinted – go ahead and become a Level 2 volunteer now, and you are all set for 75% of your student's high school career! Even if you are *considering* chaperoning a field trip, football game, competition, or social event... go ahead and become a volunteer NOW!

How can I check my volunteer status?

Log into the Raptor Volunteer system and check when your status expires. You can also email the UHS Volunteer Coordinator, Stephanie Caruso (<u>CarusoS@lake.k12.fl.us</u>) and Mr. Innis (<u>InnisY@lake.k12.fl.us</u>).

What is the Band Booster program?

The UHS Band Booster program is open to ALL BAND PARENTS. The Booster Board are a group of band parents that help run the monthly booster meetings. The booster program helps with every aspect of the band program, and assists in making decisions for the program. Many former band parents will agree that participation in the Band Booster organization is a fun and rewarding experience; helping our students achieve is certainly a worthwhile way to spend your time. Many parents have formed friendships with each other band parents that thrive long after their children graduate. Without parental support the music department would not exist!

How can I get involved in the Band Booster program?

Come to the booster meetings – they are once a month on Mondays at 6:00 in the Band Room. Email Mr. Innis if you are interested in serving on a board. Otherwise you can fill out the "Parent Volunteer Form" in the paperwork packet to let us know how you are most interested in serving the band program! Joining the UHS Band Boosters is a great way to spend time with your child and know where they are... and who they're hanging out with!
